Words of the Week and then Creed Part IV

- Word of the Week is *Concupiscence*
- “I believe in the Holy Spirit ...”
- 1 Cor. 12:3 (No one can say), 2:11 (No one can comprehend); Gal. 4:6 (Abba); John 3:34 (Rationing of the gifts), 14:16 (Advocate of Truth), 14:26, 15:26, 16:7, 16:13; Mtw. 28:19 (Baptizing in the name of the Holy Spirit); 1John 2:1, 1 Cor. 12:1-11
- Advocate (noun): [1] one that pleads the cause of another; specifically; one that pleads the cause of another before a tribunal or judicial court [2] one that defends of maintains a cause of proposal [3] one that supports or promotes the interests of another
